

**Minutes of meeting of St Augustine's Community Together Residents' Association
(ACT) held on 27 June 2012 at St Augustine's Hall, Norwich.**

1. Welcome from Chair of ACT, The Revd Nicholas Vesey. Attendance register circulated: 21 people at meeting. Apologies received: Adrian Holmes.
2. Minutes of last meeting (4.4.12) approved with one amendment: (para 1) Lucy Green should be Lucy Howard.
3. Matters arising: (para 3b) the metal post outside the Spar Shop at St Augustine's Gate had been removed.
4. Community safety issues: there had been two cats found dead in the churchyard area of suspected poisoning. The PCSOs (Emma and Lynne) said that there has been a spike in reported burglaries from vehicles in the area recently.
5. "Open Mike" session: A resident of Leonard Street reported a banging manhole cover in Edward Street near Leonard Street. A resident of Sussex Street reported that dog mess was not being cleansed from the streets regularly enough and weeds were not being kept down; plus waste and recycling bins were being left on the street after refuse collection day, causing obstructions.
6. Alan Camina reported on progress towards opening the new community resource at 52 St Augustine's Street (formerly Fran's Pantry) now known as The Stage (St Augustine's Gateway Enterprise). It was run by a Trust made up of local residents and traders. Cllrs Howard and Bearman congratulated the Trust for bringing this about
